

CHIEF MINISTER VIJAY TO OPEN METTUR DAM ON AUGUST 28

Chennai, 27 August 2026: Chief Minister Vijay is expected to open the Mettur Dam

on August 28 for irrigation in the Cauvery delta region. Preparations for his visit are currently underway.

Water from the Mettur Dam is normally released every year on June 12 for Cauvery delta irrigation. Depending on the water storage level, the release may take place on schedule or be delayed.

Irrigation from the dam benefits nearly 17 lakh acres of agricultural land across 13 districts, including Salem, Namakkal, Erode, Karur, Tiruchirappalli and Thanjavur.

However, due to the low storage level in the dam, water has not been released for kuruvai cultivation even after nearly 70 days. Farmers have been demanding that

the government take steps to release water for delta irrigation.

Meanwhile, rainfall in the Cauvery catchment areas has increased inflow into the Mettur Dam. The water level stood at 88.43 feet yesterday, with an inflow of 10,807 cusecs. As a result, the water level has been gradually rising.

Normally, when water is not released on June 12, the authorities consider opening the dam once the water level reaches around 90 feet. The level is expected to reach 90 feet within the next couple of days.

During the Assembly session yesterday, opposition members had asked when the Mettur Dam would be opened. Responding to them, Water Resources Minister Anand said that a positive announcement would be made soon.



Meanwhile, Salem District Superintendent of Police Kuthalingam conducted a surprise inspection of the Mettur Dam yesterday. He inspected the right bank, the upper-level sluice gate area and other sections, besides reviewing security and precautionary measures.

Water Resources Department Executive Engineer Selvaraj, Assistant Engineers Satheesh and Prasanth, and DSP Shanmugasundaram were present during the inspection. With the possibility of water release drawing closer, preparatory works at the Mettur Dam have been intensified.

In this backdrop, reports indicate that Chief Minister Vijay is likely to open the Mettur Dam on August 28. He is expected to arrive at Salem's Kamalapuram Airport by flight and travel by road to Mettur, where he will formally release water for delta irrigation. Arrangements for the Chief Minister's visit are underway.

COAST GUARD, TN GOVT DISCUSS FISHERMEN SAFETY

Chennai, 27 August 2026: Coastal security, safety of fishermen and measures to improve emergency response at sea were among the key issues discussed during a meeting between Indian Coast Guard Director General Paramesh Sivamani and Tamil Nadu Chief Minister C. Joseph Vijay in Chennai.

Sivamani, who called on the Chief Minister, stressed the need to equip fishing vessels with Distress Alert Transmitters and

mandatory lifesaving equipment to improve the chances of survival during maritime emergencies. The meeting also covered search and rescue operations, prevention of illegal activities at sea, marine environmental conservation and the welfare of Coast Guard veterans.

The Coast Guard chief briefed Vijay on recent search and rescue operations in which fishermen, including those from Tamil Nadu, were rescued. He also



highlighted the Coast Guard's role in assisting the state administration during natural disasters and cyclones.

The meeting reaffirmed cooperation between the state government and the Coast Guard on protecting fishing communities and strengthening maritime security along the Tamil Nadu coast.

"Spoke to Prime Minister Balendra Shah and conveyed condolences on the loss of lives due to the floods in Nepal. The people of India stand in solidarity with their sisters and brothers in Nepal at this difficult time. India is ready to provide all possible humanitarian assistance to Nepal. Our teams are coordinating closely on rescue and relief efforts," PM Modi posted on X.

PM Modi said he has spoken to his Nepali counterpart, Balen Shah, and assured him that New Delhi will "provide all possible humanitarian assistance" to the neighbour

Kingdom and Malaysia, were reported missing as a result of the flash flood. The worst affected area, Rasuwa district, witnessed similar flash floods to those in August last year, when a glacial lake in neighboring Tibet overflowed as a result of high temperatures in the mountain region.

TRUMP SAYS IT'S TIME TO TEACH CANADA A LESSON AFTER TRADE TALKS COLLAPSE

2026: U.S. President Donald Trump said on Wednesday that it was "time to teach Canada you can't do this anymore," just days after trade talks between the neighboring countries broke down.

"I had a deal, that was a pretty good deal, you know, quite good," Trump told Glenn Beck in an interview. "They don't have anything that we have to have, okay, we can get by.

I mean, there are a couple of things that would make it a little inconvenient, but we can get them elsewhere.

And it's time to teach Canada you can't

Trump imposed new 50% tariffs on \$20 billion of Canadian imports on Saturday after talks between the two countries collapsed.

Canada hit back on Tuesday with retaliatory tariffs on about \$20 billion worth of U.S. annual imports and rolled out aid for businesses and workers, matching Washington's latest duties dollar for dollar. They take effect on September 8.

Trump also announced 50% tariffs on Canadian autos and parts that will take effect on January 1.

Canada has said that the U.S. refused to



extend tariff relief to medium- and heavy-duty vehicles as one reason it did not reach an agreement.

The Canadian Embassy in Washington did not immediately comment on Wednesday.

White House adviser Peter Navarro predicted on Wednesday that the deal Canada will ultimately strike with the U.S. will be worse than what was offered last week.

"It just is not going to end well for Canada and I predict that the

deal you got, that you turned your nose up, you're never going to get that deal again," Navarro said on C-SPAN.

"Whatever you get is going to be less than that."

Navarro added that the U.S. deal offered to Canada "made me uncomfortable" given how advantageous he thought it was for the U.S.' northern neighbor.

"There's no way economically they should have turned it down," Navarro said.

MGM CANCER INSTITUTE USES VACUUM-ASSISTED TECHNIQUE TO REMOVE BREAST LUMP, PRESERVING NATURAL BREAST APPEARANCE

Chennai, 27 August 2026: MGM Cancer Institute’s Clinic B has successfully treated a 33-year-old IT professional from Chennai for two benign breast masses in the same breast. One of the masses was located near the areolar region, while the second was situated in the middle portion of the breast.

Considering the location of the two breast masses, each required a different treatment approach. One of the masses was removed through conventional open surgery, as the procedure required removal of some overlying skin along with a margin of normal tissue. The resulting scar, located near the areola, is discreet and is expected to become less visible with time.

The second mass, located in the middle portion of the breast, was removed using VAE that uses suction to remove certain breast lumps without conventional open surgery. The procedure helped avoid a second surgical scar, sutures and significant breast distortion.

In her comments, Dr Kirti Katherine Kabeer, consultant



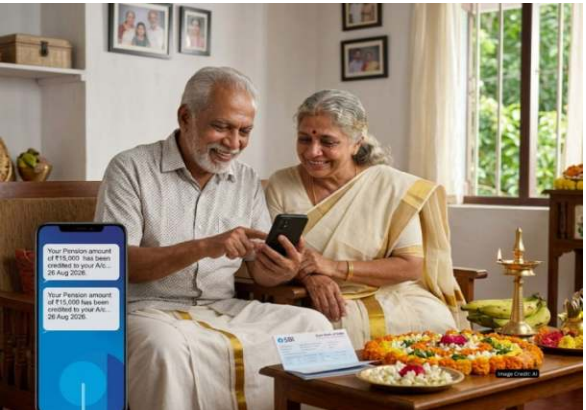
breast oncology, who led the surgical team, said, “Fibroadenoma is common among young women. Approximately 55-70% of them are diagnosed with breast fibroadenoma. The fibroadenoma does not become cancerous, but it can continue to grow and cause pain, discomfort or distortion of the breast. In this case, the patient had two lumps in the same breast and they required different approaches. One lump needed open surgery because some of the overlying skin and a margin of normal tissue had to be removed, while VAE was chosen for the other specifically to avoid a second scar. The procedures were successful. The patient was discharged the same day and, with a supportive bra during the post-procedure period, was able to return to her normal routine within a few days.”

On the minimally invasive surgery, she added that “VAE has come as a boon for removing breast lumps in young women, particularly from an aesthetic perspective. In this procedure, we use ultrasound imaging to precisely locate the breast lump and insert a specialised probe through a small opening in the breast. The probe uses vacuum suction to draw the lump towards the device, while a cutting mechanism removes the tissue in small pieces through the same probe. We continue the process until the lump is completely excised. As there is no conventional surgical incision, stitches are usually not required, helping minimise visible scarring and preserve the natural appearance of the breast.”

PRIORITY FOR TAMIL-MEDIUM STUDENTS IN GOVT JOBS: GOVERNOR APPEALS

Chennai, 27 August 2026: Tamil Nadu Governor Rajendra Vishwanath Arlekar has given his assent to a bill providing priority in government jobs to candidates who have studied through the Tamil medium.

Under the provision, 20% of the vacancies filled through direct recruitment in all Tamil Nadu government departments will be earmarked on a preferential basis for those who have studied in Tamil medium. A law to this effect was enacted in 2010.

Under the existing law, the government had been giving preference to Tamil-

medium students now given his assent to the amendment. Students who did not enter school in Class 1 but joined directly in Classes 2 to 8 under the Right to Education Act, studied in Tamil medium and passed their classes, will also be eligible. Students who studied in Tamil medium in other states and subsequently continued their education in Tamil medium in Tamil Nadu from the class in which they joined will also qualify. Candidates must obtain certificates from all the educational institutions they attended, confirming that they studied in Tamil medium up to the educational qualification prescribed for the post.

The amended law provides 20% preferential reservation for Tamil medium candidates. It also specifies that the amended provisions will apply only to new recruitments made hereafter. Who is eligible? According to the amendment: Only candidates who have studied entirely in Tamil medium, from Class 1 up to the educational qualification prescribed for the government post, will be eligible for the preference. Candidates who studied in another language as their medium of instruction but merely wrote their examinations in Tamil
