## MINISTERS MEET PROTESTING SANITATION WORKERS, ASSURE EARLY SOLUTION TO THEIR GRIEVANCES

Chennai, 05 Sep 2026: Chennai Corporation sanitation workers, who have been staging a continuous protest for the past 15 days demanding permanent employment, higher wages and other benefits, were assured of an early solution to their grievances following talks with a group of Ministers at the Ripon Buildings on Friday.

Ministers Aadhav Arjuna, Rajmohan and Nirmal Kumar held discussions with representatives of the protesting sanitation workers at the Ripon Buildings. The talks focused on the workers' nine-point charter of demands, including regularisation of employment, equal pay for equal work, settlement of pending wages and arrears, job and social security, compensation in the event of accidents or death,

healthcare benefits, retirement benefits and seniority-based increments.

The talks came a day after the issue was raised in the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly. Leader of the Opposition Udhayanidhi Stalin had moved a special attention motion on the continuing protest and questioned why the Chief Minister or Ministers had not directly met the workers at the protest venue.

Udhayanidhi Stalin said sanitation workers had been protesting for 15 days seeking implementation of promises relating to permanent employment and wage increases. He also pointed out that Ministers and the Mayor had directly held talks with protesting workers during the previous government. Responding to the issue,

Minister Rajmohan said the government was fully aware of the difficult ties faced by the protesting workers and that files relating to several of their demands were ready. However, he said some of the major demands involved administrative issues as well as serious financial implications.

Rajmohan said he had personally held detailed discussions with representatives of the sanitation workers twice in his chamber, with each meeting lasting a round three-and-a-half hours. He also recalled that sanitation workers had staged protests lasting 100 to 150 days during the previous regime.

Udhayanidhi Stalin asked whether the government intended to wait until the present protest crossed 100 days before resolving the issue. Rajmohan assured the Assembly that the necessary government documents had been prepared and that a favourable solution to the workers' grievances would be reached soon. Against this backdrop, the Ministers held talks with the protesting workers at Ripon Buildings on Friday. The discussions are expected to pave the way for relief to the workers, who have been pressing for long-term employment security and improved wages and welfare benefits.

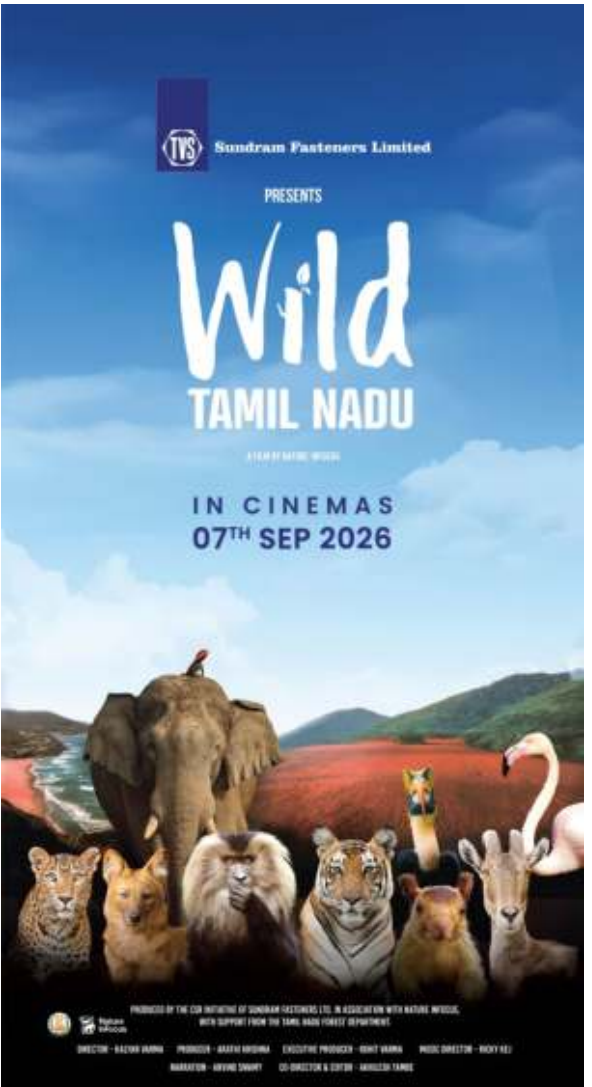

FUTURE OF TRADE DEAL WITH US HINGES ON PREFERENTIAL TARIFF TERMS, SAYS PIYUSH GOYAL

Chennai, 05 Sep 2026: Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal has said it will announce the India-US Bilateral Trade Agreement (BTA) only after Washington agrees to offer India preferential tariff terms over its competitors, pointing to a key sticking point in protracted negotiations between the two countries.

"As soon as the US is able to give us the preferential rate in comparison to our competition, we will finalise the BTA and announce the final details," Goyal said at a national workshop on leveraging free-trade agreements.

NEPAL FLOOD LOSSES ESTIMATED AT \$2.56 BILLION

Chennai, 05 Sep 2026: Property, housing and infrastructure worth at least 387.5 billion Nepalese rupees (\$2.56 billion) was lost in Nepal's catastrophic floods last week, the country's disaster authority chief told Reuters on Friday.

In the first four months of early recovery, the estimated cost to build roads and temporary shelters, provide drinking water and restore power would be around \$52.6 million, Dharma Raj Upreti, chief of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Authority, said.

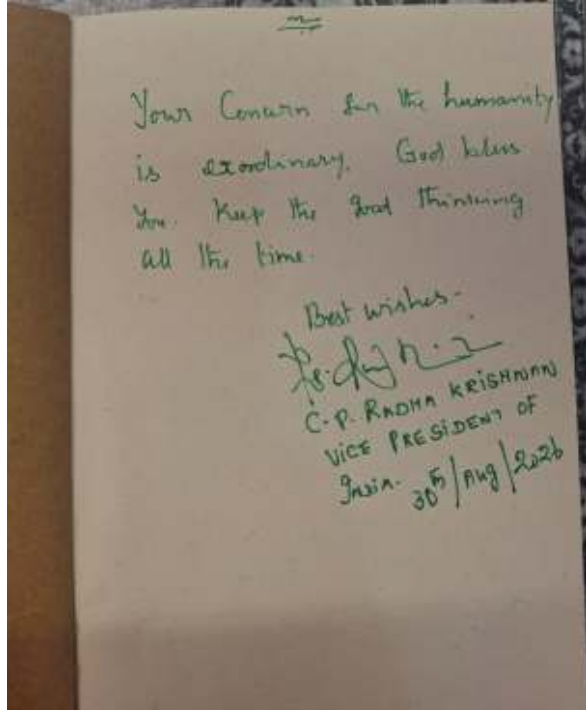
