The temporary pause that was announced by the Kremlin on Saturday, is aligned with a high-stakes visit by the special envoys of US President Donald Trump, who are travelling to Ukraine with a proposal aimed at ending the war.

Ukraine President Volodymyr Zelensky on Friday had proposed a temporary ceasefire with Russia.

"There will be no air strikes from our side, and Russia must mirror this by ensuring silence without its air strikes for the time needed to

Kyiv and other Ukrai nian cities, relentlessly striking civilian areas.

On Friday, a Russian drone hit the headquarters of Ukraine's Security Service. It is one of the most important buildings in Kyiv and

is one of the agencies that helped in carrying out strikes deep inside Russia.

The last known visit to Moscow by Witkoff and Kushner, Trump's son-in-law, was in January, when they met Putin in the Kremlin. They have never visited Kyiv, but Zelensky said he was expecting them in the Ukrainian capital on Sunday.

SPACE SECTOR CREATES HISTORY; INTERNATIONAL SPACECRAFT APPROACHES MERCURY—A MILESTONE ACHIEVEMENT AFTER AN EIGHT-YEAR JOURNEY FROM EARTH

Chennai, 06 Sep 2026: The Bepi Colombo spacecraft, launched to study Mercury—the planet closest to the Sun—has successfully reached its final destination. NASA had previously made history by sending the 'Mariner 10' (in the 1970s) and 'MESSENGER' (in 2011) probes to study Mercury.

Following this legacy, the European Space Agency and the Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency collaborated to launch the 'BepiColombo'

After traveling through space for approximately eight years and covering a distance of 10 billion kilometers, the spacecraft successfully initiated the first phase of its mission to reach Mercury—located 124 million miles from Earth—on the 3rd of this month.

Ground control officials confirmed that the scientific research modules have successfully separated from the main spacecraft assembly and have begun their journey



toward Mercury. For the first time in history, two distinct scientific probes will simultaneously orbit and study the planet.

It has been announced that the spacecraft will enter Mercury's orbit on November 21,

separate into individual research modules on December 9 and 10, and commence direct scientific observations in April 2027. Describing the challenge of

operating amidst the Sun's intense heat, Ignacio Tanco, the mission operations manager, remarked, "It is akin to working while a scorching pizza oven is burning right behind your back."

Scientists are optimistic that this mission will unravel mysteries such as the nature of Mercury's magnetic field and the presence of ice within its shadowed craters.
