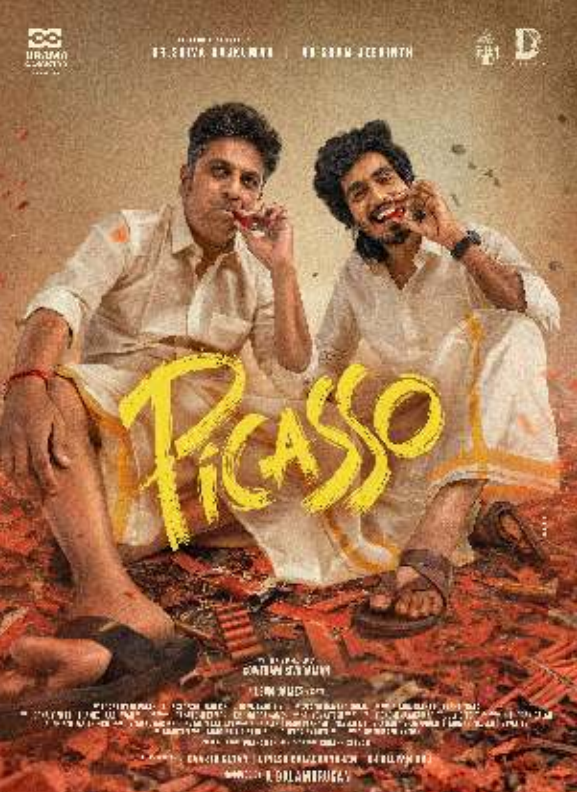

Considered a more anatomical and biologically respectful approach, the procedure enables stable reconstruction of the hip. This allows patients to resume a

broad range of normal daily activities. Such an outcome is particularly important for younger and active patients, for whom preservation of bone and maintenance of function are central considerations.

The procedures were performed following detailed clinical assessments, comprehensive imaging, medical optimisation and meticulous surgical planning. Both patients have demonstrated encouraging early functional recovery following the procedures, with good progress reported during the initial postoperative period.

In his comments, Dr. Vijay C Bose, Joint Director & Senior Consultant, Orthopedics, who led the surgical team, said, “This procedure represents a significant shift in how we approach hip replacement and reconstructive hip surgery. The goal is not simply to replace a painful joint, but to preserve as much of the patient’s own bone as possible while respecting the natural mechanics of the hip. It



is based on a simple but important principle: whenever possible, surgery should preserve the patient’s bone and work with the body’s natural anatomy.

Patient selection is critical to the success of this procedure. Suitability depends on several factors, including age, bone quality, diagnosis, anatomy, activity requirements, overall medical condition and the surgeon’s assessment. With careful patient selection, meticulous planning, advanced technology and precise surgical execution, we believe this approach can help many patients achieve a stable reconstruction and return to a highly functional and active life.”
