CBN RAJASTHAN UNIT SEIZES NEARLY FOUR TONNES OF CONTRABANDS IN INTENSIFIED ENFORCEMENT OPERATIONS ACROSS RAJASTHAN

Chennai, 27 Sep unit intercepted a truck carrying a concealed consignment of 2,292.460 kg Poppy Straw packed in 118 bags. The contraband was found concealed beneath a cover cargo of cement bags. Two persons were arrested and the truck was seized. During follow-up action, a motorcycle and a register were also recovered from the residential premises of one of the arrested persons. In another operation, CBN Rajasthan unit recovered 1,037 kg Doda Chura packed in 56 bags from a premises where a Fortuner car loaded with the contraband was found. A country-made pistol loaded with three live rounds was also recovered from the vehicle. CBN also recovered 340 kg Poppy Straw packed in 23 bags from a Tata Harrier car. In another interception, 156.7 kg Poppy Straw packed in nine bags was recovered from a Honda Amaze car after



its occupant abandoned the vehicle and fled from the spot. relevant provisions of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, 1985.

Further, 110 kg Poppy Straw was recovered from a Creta car, leading to the arrest of one person. Further intensive investigation is under way in all the cases to identify the sources, destinations, supply channels and other persons/entities associated with the illegal trafficking and distribution of narcotic drugs.

In another operation, CBN recovered 9.6 kg Opium along with ₹18.42 lakh in cash from residential premises. One person was arrested in the case. MINISTER A. RAJMOHAN ATTENDS TAMIL FILM ACTIVE PRODUCERS ASSOCIATION (TFAPA)’S 6TH ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING AND ASSURES SUPPORT FROM THE STATE GOVERNMENT ON THE REQUESTS MADE BY TFAPA

Chennai, 27 Sep 2026: The Tamil Film Active Producers Association (TFAPA) conducted its 6th Annual General Body Meeting (AGM) today at Hotel Adithya, Vadapalani, Chennai.

The AGM, conducted annually to bring together members, exchange views on the Tamil film industry, present the Association’s annual accounts and discuss new initiatives, was attended by over 150 Producer members.

The event was graced by the presence of Thiru A. Rajmohan, Hon. Minister for School Education, Tamil Development, Information & Publicity, Government of Tamil Nadu, who addressed the gathering and interacted with the members on key issues concerning the Tamil film industry.

TFAPA Presents Memorandum to Tamil Nadu Government: TFAPA presented a detailed memorandum to the Hon. Minister seeking the support and intervention of the Government of Tamil Nadu on several important issues affecting the growth and sustainability of Tamil cinema.

The Hon. Minister went through the requests and, during his address, spoke in detail about each one of them and the steps being considered by the Government.

The key requests presented by TFAPA included:

1. Removal of the 4% Local Body Enter



tainment Tax, which is currently charted only in Tamil Nadu.

2. Regular presentation of the Tamil Nadu State Government Film Awards, including the clearance of awards for pending years.

3. Disbursement of pending subsidies for small-budget films for the past 11 years and continuation of the subsidy scheme on a regular annual basis, along with a request to enhance the subsidy from ₹7 lakh to ₹10 lakh.

4. Single-window shooting permissions across Tamil Nadu, including permission to shoot on city roads, to facilitate smoother and more efficient film production.

5. Implementation of a Movie Ticket Tracking System to provide Producers with online theatre collection information after every show, with the objective of bringing greater transparency and helping prevent revenue leakages.

6. Annual financial support from the Government of Tamil Nadu for a new OTT platform proposed by the Producer Associations, with the objective of creating a dedicated platform for the streaming of small-budget Tamil films.

7. Establishment of

a State-supported anti-piracy organisation to strengthen efforts to control and combat film piracy.

US-IRAN WAR TO RESUME IN NOVEMBER? TRUMP REJECTS TEHRAN'S 7-DAY PEACE PLAN

Chennai, 27 Sep and normal maritime passage restored within seven days," Iran's Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi told reporters at the UN on Friday.

2026: President Donald Trump has reportedly rejected Iran's proposal for a seven-day ceasefire and is likely to resume bombing Tehran after the November mid-term elections in the US.

The proposal was discussed by the Iranian foreign minister at a private gathering on the sidelines of the UN General Assembly.

"The choice now rests with the United States. Iran does not accept coercion, threats, or intimidation, and Iran will not surrender its sovereign rights under pressure," he said. "I can tell you if there is seriousness in the US side to come to a deal and reopen the Strait of Hormuz, everything is now prepared," he added.

Tehran had proposed to reopen the strategic waterway Strait of Hormuz and end fighting -- which began on February 28 when the US and Israel conducted joint strikes on Iran -- within seven days if the US agreed to its demands.

Tehran's new proposal resembled an agreement reached in June that later collapsed.

He also posted an image on his Truth Social platform of a map showing Hormuz circled and labelled "Trump Strait."

Iranian President Masoud Pezeshkian said in an interview with broadcaster CBS that the ceasefire "process will begin from the very day they accept it."

Iran's 7-Day Plan To End War

Iran said it would reopen Hormuz -- the world's most vital energy conduit -- and resume talks on its nuclear program in seven days if the US lifts its naval blockade, ...if the United States waives oil sanctions and observes a ceasefire that includes Lebanon.

"We had previously reached an agreement based on the MOU that was signed in Pakistan ...if the United States agrees to proceed in that way, everything will return to the way it was before," he said.
